OVERVIEW

The Union Cabinet in its meeting held on 27th March, 2008 accorded approval to establish North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda & Homoeopathy at Shillong to provide health care to the people of NE Region and Sikkim under Ayurveda and Homoeopathy systems of medicine. The institute is to have Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic colleges with the admission capacity of 50 students each along with a 100 bed Ayurvedic hospital and a 50 bed Homoeopathic hospital, Documentation-cum-R&D Centre and Pharmacy with Drug Testing Laboratory.

The Institute is coming up on a plot of land measuring 20 Acres adjacent to the North Eastern Indira Gandhi Regional Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (NEIGRIHMS) at Mawdiangdiang, Shillong, Meghalaya and at present the institute is running an OPD city center at Nongrim hills, Shillong and providing health care services to the general masses of Shillong and adjacent areas with Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic mode of treatment. The construction of Hospital and College buildings under Phase —I of the project is in progress .Total sanctioned cost of project is Rs.71.81 crore.

The main aim and objectives of NEIAH, Shillong

- To provide under graduate, post graduate, doctoral and post-doctoral teaching, research facilities and quality patient care services under the Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic systems of medicine;
- To conduct experiments and develop patterns of teaching in under graduate and post graduate education in all branches of the Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic systems of medicine;
- To conduct research on various aspects of Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic systems of medicine;
- To provide medical care through Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic systems of medicine to the suffering humanity;
- To conduct refresher courses for Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic systems of medicine;
- To develop, promote and propagate the science and art of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy as the case may be;

The institute once come out will be a unique one and be operated independently by the management of the institute and collocated beside NEIGRIHMS with multi-specialty, where education and health care facilities through Ayurveda & Homoeopathy will provide in one platform. Moreover, it is designed to facilitate the promotion of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy system of medicines, expansion of health care facilities and to bring improvement in doctor-population ratio and R&D on bio-resources in the entire North East.

In addition to providing health care services to the needy people the institute will function as an institution of international standard and a center of excellence in education and research for under graduation, post-graduation, post-doctorate for aspiring candidates of India and abroad and to undergo education and research in Ayurveda and Homoeopathy on its completion. Moreover, it will provide specialty medical care to the people of North Eastern States under Ayurveda and Homoeopathy system of medicines, capacity building and develop skills among Ayurveda and Homoeopathy practitioners, and will be established as a Centre of Excellence in pharmacognosy and pharmacological research related in the field of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy once it started functioning. The institute will be known as a referral center for Ayurvedic & Homoeopathic system of medicines for the people of entire North East, and to do collaborative and exchange programmes with other institutes of the country and aboard for development of Homeopathic and Ayurvedic systems of medicines and to generate public awareness about the potential of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy system of medicine for enhancing health security of rural communities including disease prevention and health promotion.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

The permanent site of the institute is developing at Mawdiangdiang, Shillong-18 and presently it is running in a rented building at Nongrim Hills, Shillong-3.

Institution Achievement Report

- At present the institute is running one OPD City Center (both Ayurveda & Homeopathy) in a rented accommodation measuring approx. 5810 Sq.ft at Nongrim Hills, Shillong and is providing health care services to the general masses.
- The Institute is coming up on a plot of land measuring 20 Acres adjacent to the North Eastern Indira Gandhi Regional Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (NEIGRIHMS) at Mawdiangdiang, Shillong, Meghalaya and at present the institute is running an OPD city center at Nongrim hills, Shillong and providing health care services to the general masses of Shillong and adjacent areas with Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic mode of treatment. The construction of Hospital and College buildings under Phase –I of the project is in progress. Total sanctioned cost of project is Rs.71.81 crore.
- Till 31st March'2013 about 55% work of Phase I of the project (which includes Ayurveda teaching block, Homeopathic teaching block, Ayurveda Hospital, Homoeopathic Hospital & Library block) has been completed physically.
- DPR for Phase II has been submitted by HSCC and the matter is under consideration of the Department of AYUSH. Phase II includes – Boys & Girls Hostels, Doctors Hostels, Family Quarters, International teaching and Residential block, PG teaching block, Nursing college & Pharmacy College, Drugs Testing Laboratory and Medicine Manufacturing unit).
- MoA, Rules and Regulations and Bye-laws of NEIAH, Shillong have been approved by the competent authority and the Institute has been registered under Meghalaya Societies Act, XII of 1983.
- Proposal for creation of required posts including faculty members and draft Recruitment Rules (RRs) for all the proposed posts to be filled up to start the functioning of the institute is in progress.
- A total of 12,198 patients (Ayurveda 7960 and Homoeopathy 4238) with an average of 50 60 patients per day have visited and benefitted from the city OPD centre from 1st April '2012 to 31st March'2013. Patients were provided with free medicines as per availability.

- Every efforts are on to start the colleges from the academic session 2013-14 accordingly proposals have been sent to respective Councils i.e. CCIM and CCH for permission to start the college and NEHU, Shillong for affiliation for the courses.
- The Medical Officers of NEIAH had under gone various Training Programme/ Seminar/
 Conference under continued medical education programme for enriching & up gradation
 of the technical knowledge of the officials which would help in rendering quality health
 care services to the general masses. The officials have attended National Interactive
 Workshop on "Sukravaha srotas and Artavavaha srotas, their srotodusti vikar &
 Management organized by Rastriya Ayurveda Vidyapeeth, New Delhi in collaboration
 with Govt. Ayurvedic College, Guwahati, (IIE, Guwahati) and CME Programme
 (Homoeopathic) on Mother and Child Health held at Jowai, Meghalaya
- The official Website of NEIAH, Shillong ie. www.neiah.nic.in has been launched and is being regularly updated.
- NEIAH is providing Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic system of medical treatment to Central Government Employees in collaboration with CGHS Wellness Centre.
- The facility at OPD City Centre, NEIAH was upgraded by installing LAN (Local Area Network) for better treatment and more medical information for Doctors. National Informatics' Centre, Shillong has been requested to develop special software for documentation of Dispensary.
- CCTV has been installed for increasing security and monitoring.
- The institute has published 1st issue of Annual Magazine namely "AYUHOM" and the 2nd issue of "AYUHOM" is under publication. So far three issues of NEWS LETTER have been published by the institute.
- NEIAH Shillong organized two health camps in the East Khasi Hill District of Meghalaya (on 12th May'2012 & 5 – 6 Oct'2013) to promote and popularize the Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy.
- Dr. Bishnu Choudhury is delivered a Guest Lecture on Ayurveda & Management of common diseases at Atomic minerals Directorate for Exploration R Research, Dept. of Atomic Energy, North Eastern Region, Govt. of India, AMD Complex, Nongmynsong, Shillong on dated 26.03.2013.

HOSPITAL STATUS

OPD City Centre at a Glance -

North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda & Homoeopathy (NEIAH), Shillong, is running a OPD centre in a rented building of Meghalaya State Housing Financing Co-operative Society Ltd. at Nongrim Hills, Shillong-3, since 4th November'2010. At present, there are two doctors each from Ayurveda and Homoeopathy available for consultation at the OPD centre where the number of patients is gradually increasing day by day. A total of 12,198 patients (Ayurveda - 7960 and Homoeopathy – 4238) have visited and benefitted from the OPD centre from 1st April '2012 to 31st March'2013. Most of the patients are visiting the OPD centre mainly for treatment of Osteoarthritis, Rheumatoid arthritis, Gout, Hypertension, Acid peptic disorder, Skin diseases, Diabetes mellitus, Constipation, Ethanol intoxication and Neurological disorder etc.
